EXAMINATION FINDINGS

Bena was evaluated by our veterinary team and under our care from the 9th/12/24 to the 30/12/24. On the 30/12/24 the decision was made to humanely euthanise Bena.

- **Description** of the condition:

Bright alert and responsive

Calm nature, reserved animal

Mucous membranes: Pink, moist

Heart and chest auscultation: NAD

Temperature: 38C

Body condition score: Good, 4 out of 9 on the Nestle Purina Body System score,

Blood smear: NAD

Coat: Coat mildly dirty, flea dirt present. Ticks present on ear

Musculoskeletal: moderate limp on right hind limb, painful when palpated. No obvious long bone fractures felt.

Patella and cruciate ligament evaluation: NAD

Radiographs: Acetabular rim fracture of right hip joint

- **Cause:** Traumatic injury of great force.

- **Duration** of the condition: Acute

- **Prognosis** – Good

- **Recommendation** – While in our care, this animal was treated with cage rest, pain control and anti-inflammatories.
