I heard the knock, I heard the taser gun and the barking stopped, I then proceeded to go look who it is and on my way to go see who it is knocking, I heard the taser gun again for the second time as I looked through the window, I saw him put the taser gun in his pocket. I really didn't appreciate that fact that he had a taser gun facing my Dogs way.
