Upon arrival, myself and Inspector Rowan Davids from the Cape of Good Hope SPCA met with the owner, Zaan Philander, who granted us access to the property.

We observed the dog in question, still on a static chain of inadequate length, fair body condition with access to adequate shelter and water however the water was dirty with some sand.

I asked Zaan when will he sort out the running chain, and he said he is still struggling with getting a long enough line for the running chain. I told him he needs to sort it out before we take the dog for sterilization, and he must ensure the water available is clean for the dog.

I issued a warning, 21824, to:

- Provide the animal with sufficient potable water 24 hours a day.
- As a last resort place the animal on a running chain within 6 days.

The warning was cosigned by myself and Inspector Rowan Davids, and Mr Zaan Philander signed and accepted the notice.
