Upon arrival, myself and Inspector Lwazi Ntungele knocked and shouted but there was no answer at the property. While we were there, two young boys approached us and introduced themselves as Cameron and Jordan, both minors. They informed us that they are neighbour's who look after the dog Chico when no one is there. They took us to the back where we observed the dog in question still on a static tether of inadequate length. The dog has access to adequate shelter but there was no water available for the dog. We asked the boys if the owner has said anything about sorting out the running chain, but they said they did not hear anything. They did say they are going to fetch a bucket of water now for the dog, and will see if they can get a line for

the running chain as well.
I issued a warning, 21827, to:

- Provide the animal with sufficient potable water 24 hours a day
- As a last resort, place the animal on a running chain within 3 days.

Myself and Inspector Lwazi Ntungele cosigned the warning and gave it to the boys to give to the owner. They could not sign as they are minors.
