The mother informed us they dog has a running chain but its not set up yet. I told her the owner needs to ensure the running chain is installed as soon as possible, as we have given more than enough time for it to be sorted. I issued a warning, 21828, to:

• As a last resort place the animal on a running chain within 3 days.
