Thank you both for your sensitivity and professionalism during your visits concerning the tragic loss of my puppy, Friday. I understand and acknowledge the limitations faced in the absence of direct evidence, and I respect the SPCA's position regarding prosecution.

For my own personal records and closure, I would be very grateful if you could provide a brief written confirmation of your key observations. This would help me create a complete timeline of events.

Kindly, could you please confirm the following factual points from your respective investigations?

For Inspector Ngcofe (Saturday visit):

1. Could you confirm the time you examined Friday's body on Saturday evening?
2. Could you note your observation regarding the body's temperature at that time?
3. What was your observation regarding the condition of her coat (e.g., the presence of grease or other substances)?
4. Did you note any signs that would suggest the puppy had been trapped inside the washing machine for an extended period (e.g., since midday)?

For Inspector Mfini (Monday visit):

1. Could you confirm that you interviewed my brother, Tome, on Monday?
2. Would you be able to provide a brief summary of the warning or advice you relayed to me that you gave to him following that interview?

Please note that I **am not seeking** legal conclusions but I am simply seeking a factual record of what you observed and the actions you took, as this will be valuable for my own path forward.
