FINDINGS

Confinement of animal/s: Static chain - inadequate length ***
Reason for being chained or caged: Scared of the dog being getting out, or hurt by people outside
Adequate space: No ***
Clean living environment: Yes
Water available: Yes
Adequate shelter available: Yes
Animal/s in good condition: Yes

Upon arrival, myself and Inspector Lwazi Ntungele of Cape of Good Hope SPCA met with the father of the owner of the dog, Mr Lionel Kortje, who granted us access to the property.

We observed an adult male X breed dog, fair body condition and but once again on a static chain of inadequate length. The dog had access to adequate shelter and water. The living area was clean as well. Mr Kortje explained that he had put the dog on the chain again as he had gone to the shop and was afraid the dog would get out the property.. I told him that I do not see a way for the dog to escape the property as it is fully enclosed, therefore that is not a sufficient reason to chain the dog. I asked Mr Kortje to immediately loosen the dog and to also give me the chain as they do not require it. He complied and handed the chain over to me.

I issued a warning, 21820, to:

- Unchain the animal immediately to roam freely inside the property, and to refrain from chaining the dog at any time.

The warning was consigned by myself and Inspector Lwazi Ntungele. The warning was signed and accepted by Mr Lionel Kortje on behalf of his son, Mr Adrian Kortje.
