Confinement of animal/s: Static chain - inadequate length ***
Reason for being chained or caged: Unknown

Upon arrival, myself and Inspector Lwazi Ntungele of Cape of Good Hope SPCA knocked and shouted but there was no answer at the property. The gate was open, and we could observe the small female X breed juvenile dog, fair body condition but on a static chain of inadequate length. The dog had no shelter and there was a water bucket with potable water, but it was too far for the dog to reach. The living area was clean as well. We did not see the adult female dog while we were at the property. I issued a warning, 21820, to:

* Unchain the animal immediately to roam freely inside the property, or as a last resort place the animal on a running chain within 7 days.

* Provide the animals with sufficient potable water 24 hours a day.

* Provide the animals with adequate shelter against the elements within 7 days.

The warning was co-signed by myself and Inspector Lwazi Ntungele. The warning was left on the front door of the house.
