I observed the two adult male dogs in question, still in fair body condition and free roaming on the property. The dogs water bowl was filled with clean potable water this time, and there was still the one shelter outside. Ashweldo informed us that the shelter must still be extended but his mom might buy an extra one as well. I told him that we can give an extension, but they need to please sort it out. He also said they agreed for sterilization, so I will arrange that on the follow up next week. The puppy inside the house was also observed still in fair body condition as well.

I issued a warning notice, 21839, to:

1. Provide the animals with adequate shelter against the elements within 6 days.
