Upon arrival, myself and Inspector Lee Prins from the Cape of Good Hope SPCA met with Denver Samson, a resident on the property and who granted us access to the property. I observed the adult female dog in question, fair body condition but she had given birth recently to what appears to be 7 puppies. The dog was however tethered this time on a short rope, and she had water, but the bowl was very dirty. There were no more hazardous materials laying around, and the area was clean. I asked Denver why the dog is tied but he said he doesn't know why. We explained to him the dog cannot be tied and also the dogs water bowl must be cleaned.

I issued a warning notice, 21841, to:

1. Provide the animal with sufficient potable water 24 hours a day.
2. Untie/unchain the animal immediately to roam freely inside the property.

The warning was co-signed by Inspector Lee Prins and I and was signed and accepted by Mr. Denver Samson on behalf of the owner Reginald Hendricks. He also untied the dog immediately and started washing the water bowl.
