The challenge that they have are animals that roaming around in the street, infected with mange and fleas and ticks. The community of Phumlani spoke with Zolile and some staff to ask the SPCA for help.

This morning i spoke with Inspectorate Magdelene offered help to take in series and unwanted animals.

The mobiles will give rabies, deworming and tick/flea treatment.

Magdelene have a day open for an outreach on Tuesday the 18th November 2025.

She will have collecting officers and Law Enforcement officers available.

For now we have no clinic for the fourth Mobile.
