Upon arrival, myself and Inspector Lee Prins from the Cape of Good Hope SPCA met with the owner, Mrs Angelique Crowster, who granted us access to the property. I observed the adult dog in question, still in fair body condition and free roaming on the property. The living area was clean, and there was clean water available. There was also adequate shelter available now. The owner states she got the shelter and the warning was co-signed by Inspector Lee Prins and I and was signed and the dog immediately started using it. I reiterated to her the importance of shelter for the animals, as she could see now how much he enjoys using it. I asked if we could see the cat but we looked and could not find it. Angelique says the cat roams the area sometimes, where I stressed the need for the cat and also the dog to be sterilized to prevent unnecessary breeding. She agreed and requested to have them both sterilized. I informed her I will have my office arrange the sterilization.
