I asked if he knows if the owner is still interested in sterilization and he said yes, once the puppies are old enough, he would like the dog sterilized please. I informed him that I will have my office arrange it in about 2 months' time once the puppies are older and don't rely on the mother. From the welfare side, this case can be closed. NFA
