Upon arrival, myself and Inspector Lee Prins from the Cape of Good Hope SPCA met with the owner, Mr Ashweldo Pietersen, who granted us access to the property. I observed the 2 adult dogs and the puppy lounging under the carport, still in fair body condition and free roaming on the property. The living area was clean, and there was clean water available. There was also an adequate shelter available now for the dog Jackie that sleeps outside. The owner states they bought it yesterday after I explained to him the next steps that comes after I issued the final warning previously. He said he did actually want to just expand the shelter the dog had previously, but he admits he was taking too long so he just asked his dad to buy a kennel for now. I reiterated to him the importance of shelter for the animals and thanked him for sorting it out. He asked if we would still do the sterilization, where I reassured him that it will be arranged and my office will be in touch to set a date for collection of the 2 adult dogs and then for the puppy

once it gets older.
