Subject: Lane Stables horse cruelty

Dear Cape of Good Hope SPCA,
I hope you are doing well.

I'm deeply concerned about the welfare of the horses at this stable in at Lane Stables Constantia. During my visit, I observed all the horses confined to a single sandy paddock with no shade, no visible access to drinking water, and constant exposure to direct sunlight.

It was also evident that the horses are being ridden repeatedly without sufficient rest or rotation . In such, watching one horse been ridden looks so sick and it's extremely cruel . This kind of treatment raises serious animal welfare concerns and should be investigated by the SPCA or another appropriate authority.

Horses are sentient animals that require proper shelter, hydration and rest especially in warm climates like ours. What I witnessed reflects a lack of basic care standards and respect for these animals' wellbeing.

I strongly urge anyone who cares about animal welfare to report these conditions to the SPCA Cape of Good Hope so that the horses can receive the care and oversight they deserve.
