When the dogs were confiscated, the owner had 7 days to present themselves to the SPCA to formally lay claim to the animals, which include completing necessary paperwork and proving that the animals belong to them. Unfortunately, the owner never came to the SPCA and therefore has no right to lay claim to the animals any longer.

We hope this is clear to you.

Yes, that is unfortunately the sad reality we face on a daily basis. We can only hope that if she gets more animals that they will not be kept in the same conditions. If their welfare is compromised again, then we will not hesitate to step in and assist the animals where needed.
