Dear Inspectorate

I value and appreciate what you do for the safety and well-being of animals, but I assure you that those two pensioners look well after their animals.

I assist them in buying food on a regular basis. John-Boy, a very cheeky parrot who couldn't get along with his previous owners due to his nature of harsh screeching and biting, was totally relaxed at their house. He got his fruit and vitamins, deworming and their cats are sterilized, vaccinated and dewormed and they are healthy with healthy skin.

Unfortunately there are people who are really nasty towards us, especially a Mr Jannie Behm, residing at 45 Tyger crescent who also breeds canaries and keep white doves. Unfortunately Mr Behm is an alcoholic who complains if our grass are just a little bit bushy.

Also family or friend of Marais who are stealing whatever they can get from the old people.

I know the Marais household for years. Since advanced technology took over they fell behind as they are not IT literate. I set up a phone for them but they battle to use it.

Mariana had a brain operation and are not 100% mindful the last few months but her main love is her pets. Louis sits in the mornings and during the day with his ducks, cuddling and talking to them. All their birds get individual attention and are well taken care of. The cats are free during the day and locked up at night.

They feed their animals before worrying about food for themselves and reached out to me 2 years ago to assist them. I got someone to clean the house, but I was extremely busy the last few weeks to supervise the cleaning.

I am involved in animal care, organized the mobile clinic in Klipkop on Wednesdays and catch strays and see that they get good homes. I visit those animals and have regular contact with their rescuers. Roxanne at AACL knows me as well as Papa G and the other kind staff at Epping AACL.

I follow Jaco Pieterse and called him out to a few people who where neglecting their dogs.

I also logged a complaint about 2 unsterilized German Shepherds at 30 Charl Uys street (my neighbour on the corner) with which Ivan, the owner of the German Shepherds wanted to breed without a license and without feeding the dogs properly. So that complaint was apparently swept under the carpet because nothing was done about it by the SPCA. I think it was the morning of 5 September that I lodged the complaint (I do have the ref No). Unfortunately nothing was done and you will find that SPCA received a call from the owner to take the dogs away because they killed her one Yorkie and badly injured her other Yorkie. This happened in Saturday afternoon 1 November.

So I plead to you to please return Louis and Marisna's "babies" ASAP. They are devastated. They are also very scared for the family who robs them so you need to use my name "Estelle" as a password

when you call them at the gate. They are pensioners and cannot drive so far to Grassy Park and neither can I to assist them. My pension don't allow unnecessary driving unfortunately. I am not home tomorrow but you can leave a message on my WhatsApp if you need me or need to speak to me. (I work 8 hrs per week for extra Income and cannot speak when I'm at work.)

So please help those 2 elderly people, they are crying day and night for their birds and ducks and especially John-Boy who is probably very traumatized now.

I will report weekly to you of progress should you require them to make any adjustments to get their birds back.

I trust that you will consider those 2 heartbroken pensioners and help them to get their pets back and if Jannie Behm reported then he deserves to be fined for what he does to his loving and caring neighbours. You are even welcome to speak to the Speelman's next door (No 48). They will also confirm that I speak the truth.

I appreciate all your hard work and as a matter of fact there's a stray cat pestering the Marais' cats, but Mariana is feeding him. He is not sterilized and attack my cats in the yard. Mariana will show him to you. I could not manage to catch him because he gets vicious. If you can be able to catch him, luring him closer with food and PLEASE take him away you will help us all as this cat is causing havoc by attacking even male cats for the last 8 months now.

Thank you for caring.

I trust that you will see the real picture about these good pensioners.
