With the owner large myself in law enforcement to conduct a inspection on the property. I observed one tan and white small crossbreed dog one black puppy, also crossbreed there was a black and white crossbreed dog with a severe injury to the eye the owner claim that the dog got off the property and was bitten by the neighbors dog the eye almost completely open um and the owner decided to surrender that dog. There was a white and tan underweight crossbreed dog adult severely May sated the owner also decided to Serena that dog over to the spca & both for euthanasia.

Myself and law enforcement went into the house it was extremely dirty there was feces all over there was no water available. I explained to the owner that the dogs cannot be kept under such conditions he needs to clean the property and a fallout inspection will be conducted within 24 hours to examine the conditions that the two remaining dogs will be kept under. No enforcement also issued a fine for align your dog off the property under the bylaw causing injury to the dark and issued a compliance notice for 14 days to clean a living environment which they will follow up on as well.

I issued a warning:

1. ensure water is available at all times.
2. ensure the dogs have adequate food at all times.
3. whenever your animals appear to be sick or injured you must procure adequate veterinary attention without delay.
4. clean the living environment within 24 hours as it is very dirty
