She also advised that she is going to grabouw this weekend for a potentia job offer which will require her to relocate to a more suitable home, which will be big enough for her cats. Mrs Muir was informed should she not be successful in rehoming the adult cats , the option of surrendering the adult cats to the spca to ensure compliance with bylaws. An extension of 7 days on compliance was given. Will follow up in nxt 7 days
