Good morning, Inspector L. Prins

As per your request (Ref:14920), we took our dog, Bovril, for a veterinary check-up immediately after your visit yesterday, for peace of mind.

Dr R. de Villers from Brackenfell Animal Clinic examined Bovril and reviewed his anti-inflammatory medication. The vet has prescribed PetCam to alternate with the Coxflam that we have been administering over the past year.

Bovril now has a six-month prescription for the new medication. We will continue taking him for regular six-monthly check-ups for script renewal and further medical recommendations from Dr de Villers.

Please find attached the veterinary visit documentation and proof of medication. Dr de Villers has indicated that you are welcome to contact him directly should you wish to discuss the matter further.
