TRACING REQUEST: PLEASE INSPECT AS PER THE EMAIL RECEIVED - A DOG WAS LEFT UNATTENDED INSIDE THE VEHICLE OF THE OWNER FOR APPROXIMATELY 20 MINUTES. THE CAR WAS NOT PARKED UNDER ANY SHADING AND THE DRIVER'S SIDE WINDOW WAS THE ONLY SOURCE OF VENTILATION FOR THE DOG AS IT WAS OPENED APPROXIMATELY 4CM. THE DOG WAS SEEN PANTING BUT NOT HEAVILY, AND THE COMPL SAYS SHE PUT HER FINGER IN THROUGH THE OPEN CAR WINDOW, AND THE INSIDE OF THE CAR FELT HOTTER THAN THE OUTSIDE. THE OWNER CAME OUT OF PICK N PAY LIQUOR 20 MINUTES LATER AND HE AND THE COMPL GOT INTO A VERBAL ALTERCATION AS SHE CONFRONTED HIM FOR LEAVING HIS DOG IN THE VEHICLE UNATTENDED. THE DOG IN QUESTION IS AN ADULT TAN/WHITE JACK RUSSELL THAT DID NOT APPEAR TO BE DISTRESSED BESIDES THE STARTING OF THE PANTING. THE CAR IN QUESTION IS A WHITE DOUBLE-CAB TOYOTA RAIDER WITH REGISTRATION NUMBER CA513676.
