FINDINGS

Confinement of animal/s: Static chain - inadequate length ***
Reason for being chained or caged: aggressive
Adequate space: No ***
Clean living environment: Yes
Water available: Yes
Adequate shelter available: No ***
Animal/s in good condition: Yes

Upon arrival, myself and Inspector Lee Prins from the Cape of Good Hope SPCA met with the owner, Mr. Alfeus Williams, who granted us access to the property. I observed an adult female dog, fair body condition but tied on a static chain of inadequate length. The dog had access to clean potable water but there was no shelter available. The living area was clean but limited due to the chaining. I asked the owner why the dog is chained and he said that the dog is aggressive and will bite people when they come in by the gate. He also said he has been meaning to get the shelter for the dog sorted but has not been able to yet. I told him that he will need to get the shelter sorted soon as the dog requires adequate shelter, and the dog cannot be on a static chain like that. Alfeus then said the backyard is

closed off so maybe he can put the dog there. I told him that would be best then, and then he can let the dog run freely there.

I issued a warning notice, 21835, to:

1. Provide the dog with adequate shelter against the elements within 7 days.
2. Untie/unchain the animal within 7 days.

The warning was co-signed by Inspector Lee Prins and I, and was signed and accepted by the owner Mr. Alfeus Williams
