FINDINGS

Confinement of animal/s: On running chain
Reason for being chained or caged: Dog can escape the property
Adequate space: No ***
Clean living environment: Yes
Water available: Yes
Adequate shelter available: No ***
Animal/s in good condition: No ***

Upon arrival, myself and Inspector Lee Prins from the Cape of Good Hope SPCA met with the owner , Mrs. Nicolene Marengor, who granted us access to the property. I observed an adult female dog, severely underweight and full of ticks. The dog also appeared to have a skin condition. The dog was tied on a running chain, but the running line was of inadequate length, as well as the space available for the dog was still small and I could not confidently say that the dog was able to express its natural behavior in that space. The dog had access to clean potable water but there was no shelter available. The living area was clean but limited due to the chaining. Before I could comment on anything really, the owner said she would like us to take the dog as the dog started with its skin and weight issues a few months ago and they have been unable to manage it. She also said they have another smaller dog but she runs

freely outside but we can take that dog as well as the dog also has that skin issue. She sent a young boy to locate the other dog, and the boy returned with another female dog, also appears to have a skin condition and underweight. The owner signed both dogs over to the SPCA.

I issued a warning notice, 21838, to:

1, In future, should your animal be sick or injured, provide adequate veterinary treatment immediately. Also, ensure the animals have adequate shelter against the elements and adequate space to express their natural behavior.
