FINDINGS

Confinement of animal/s: Free roaming - in property
Adequate space: Yes

Upon arrival, myself and Inspector Lee Prins from the Cape of Good Hope SPCA met with the owner , Mrs. Angelique Crowster, who granted us access to the property. I observed an adult male dog, fair body condition and free roaming on the property. The dog had access to clean potable water but there was no proper adequate shelter observed for the dog. The owner told us that she is planning to buy a kennel, because there was a kennel, but that kennel went with her brother when he moved for his new dog. I told her that she will need to sort out shelter for dog as he requires to have shelter against the elements. We then went inside the house where Angelique showed us the adult female DSH cat . The

cat was in fair body condition, free roaming in the house which also affords it adequate shelter . The cat had access to clean potable water too. I asked if the cat and dog were sterilized and the owner informed me none of them are sterilized. She did say that she won't mind having them both sterilized, where I told her I will arrange that for her.

I issued a warning notice, 21834, to:

1. Provide the animal with adequate shelter against the elements within 7 days.

The warning was co-signed by Inspector Lee Prins and I and was signed and accepted by the owner Mrs. Angelique Crowster.
