FINDINGS

Upon arrival, myself and Inspector Lee Prins from the Cape of Good Hope SPCA met with the owner , Mrs. Isabella Loesa, who granted us access to the property. I observed an adult male dog and a juvenile female dog, both in fair body condition. The dogs are free roaming on the property however the living area was quite dirty with trash. The dogs had access to adequate shelter as they have full access to the house and sleep in the house, and they have access to clean potable water in the house as well. The owner told us she has been meaning to clean the area outside but just hasn't gotten to it. We asked her to please have it clean by the time we come back for the follow up.
I issued a warning notice, 21833, to:
1. Clean and hygienically maintain the animal's living environment within 7 days.

The warning was co-signed by Inspector Lee Prins and I and was signed and accepted by the owner Mrs. Isabella Loesa. I asked Isabella about sterilization for the dogs, and she said she wouldn't mind for the adult male, but the puppy is still young. I agreed and told her we can schedule the puppy for once she is older but the adult male we can arrange after the follow up inspection.
