Upon arrival, myself and Inspector Lee Prins from the Cape of Good Hope SPCA met with a resident of the property, Mr Denver Samson, who granted us access to the property. I observed the adult dog in question, still in fair body condition and free roaming on the property. The living area was clean, and there was clean water available. The dog still had access to adequate shelter as well, and her puppies were also observed in fair condition still. However, there are only 6 left as one had passed. Denver said after we left our last notice, the dog was not tethered ever again. I thanked him and told him to inform the owner of such as well. I asked if he knows if the owner is still interested in sterilization and he said yes, once the puppies are old enough, he would like the dog sterilized please. I informed him that I will have my office arrange it in about 2 months' time once the puppies are older and don't rely on the mother.
