However, she says the dog does not use it and still prefers to sleep under the carport. I told her that its fine, as long as the dog has the option so if he ever does feel the need to use the shelter, it's there for him. She agreed and said she understands that yes and she's glad he has the shelter now. I asked if she's willing to have the dog sterilized and she agreed. I informed her I will have my office arrange the sterilization. From the welfare side, this case can be closed. NFA
