Many thanks, Peace. I hope owner Jacqui has answered your attempts at getting hold of her on Facebook and by phone 073 977 4574. Valentyn Road, Tijgerhof (Milnerton) seems a lead. See attached - she may live in or very near that road and I'm sure everyone on neighbourhood knows who Jacqui the dog "rescuer" is. Jaimin Patel at NSPCA was going to see if their tracker could track address based on the dog's owner's phone number supplied and I hope perhaps you have an address potentially by now for Jacqui van Der Veen the owner (she's one of the DiY "rescuers" out there and I do think all other animals in her "care" should also be assessed. Fyi attached. I saw Cape of Good Hope SPCA commented yesterday on her one post and I really do hope Jacqui (owner) had the integrity to reply to that message given severity of her dog's situation and that she has mentioned in a public post in recent days six days or so ago that has a lump and we know abscess which could be raging cancer or by now sepsis. Diesel's Rescue is her self styled "rescue" run out of a Capitec bank account. At least two paid towards the dog in question going to vet but she's not made a plan all these days since initial \*\*\*alleged\*\*\* vet visit of about a week ago. I have extremely little patience for the DIY "rescuer" mentality where animals end up in worse situations than when rescued, with squat timeous veterinary intervention. I'm with you to stomp out that mentality - it's sadly so common. Strength to your teams over the horrendous, inevitable fireworks season tonight.
