Thank you for the feedback. We will keep monitoring the dogs, together with the community group who are aware of the ongoing problems with these dogs over the years. Should we not see an improvement in their condition or notice that the owner is not around, we will get back to you. Unfortunately, we do not believe he has been "working odd hours and coming home late", as he claims.

After speaking to your offices earlier this morning, I believe the big black dog (Jaeger) has to see a vet within 48 hours. I will call back after 48 hours and ask for proof that this has been done. One local resident has offered to pay R500 towards the vet fee, if you want to let the owner know about that.

This matter was also reported to our local councillor, Cnlr Sherry, as well as some top brass at the Navy (who own the property), as well as to AWS and Tears. We now ALL have eyes on his conduct and if we are not satisfied that the dogs are properly cared for, the matter will have to be taken further.
