Yesterday, residents from Happy Valley asked my husband to open our gate because they had an injured dog. He witnessed a horrific scene: a dog had been struck with a hammer in the face and head by a member of the camp. The animal was rushed to Hakuna Matata Vet in West Beach, where it succumbed to its injuries. You are welcome to contact them on the following number 021 5542115. The dog's body is still there. You are welcome to ask them for a report.

This incident confirms what we have been reporting for months—there needs to be an inspection of the site and the welfare of the animals living there needs to be assessed.

This week, media outlets reported on a puppy seller in Dunoon who was arrested by the City's Law Enforcement Animal Control Unit together with the SPCA. I commend this successful operation. However, the same seriousness and urgency should be afforded to the puppy mill at Happy Valley. I have attached screenshots of social media posts showing ongoing puppy sales from the location I reported.

Given the repeated closure of complaints without investigation, misinformation between departments, and now an incident of extreme cruelty, I am urgently requesting:

1. A formal investigation at ERF 1117 (Happy Valley) into the puppy mill and the perpetrator who killed the dog yesterday. He is know by the name "Doories"
2. Intervention by the Law Enforcement Animal Control Unit, as advised by SPCA or vice versa.
3. Confirmation that this matter will not be closed again without proper inspection.
