03/02/25	Did a revisit met with owner, the dog sleeps inside the house on her dog bed & blankets. The dog has water outside gets food well & has a big e-fold for shade with a couch and mattress. I advised owner to sterilize, educated on by-laws, advised getting medicine to stop the wound from itching, wound has healed but the dog scratches the scabs open.
