Dear Ruwaida

We acknowledge receipt of your email.

Please take note that what you are saying is not the findings of the inspector when he was at the property. When you say the owner is keeping the dog locked up in the back, can you give clarification please? Is the dog in a cage? Is the dog in yard in the back for its own safety? Please clarify.

You also mention that the dog eats and drinks water when you provide it at night . This does not necessarily mean that the dog is being starved or left without water because many dogs would still eat food even after they are fully fed/ fed on a daily basis. If you have evidence that the dog is being starved and/ or being denied water, then please provide such to the SPCA.

Our records also show that the dog has kennel which means she does not choose to sleep inside it. This cannot be controlled by the owner.

You can also report this matter to City of Cape Town's Law Enforcement Animal Control Unit (021 480 7700) because part of their mandate is to deal with owners who cannot confine their animals (dogs and cats) to their property.
