EXAMINATION FINDINGS

These rabbits were evaluated on 21/2/25. The numbering corresponds with the above-mentioned rabbits.

1. Mild overlap of incisor and long nails noted.
2. Severe overlap of incisor and excessively long nails. The nails were found to be curling.
3. Incisors were misaligned and overlapped. Long nails were also noted.
4. Incisors were overlapped. Long nails were also noted.

COMMENTS

I would like to clarify that I am not an exotic veterinarian. However, it is evident that the basic principles of pet care were not followed, as shown by the excessive growth of the teeth (incisors) and nails. Overgrown teeth can prevent a rabbit from eating properly, leading to pain and discomfort. Similarly, overgrown nails can cause discomfort and lead to potential health issues, such as infections or injury. These animals have suffered unnecessarily due to the lack of proper care.
