RELEASE AGREEMENT

I, Yazeed Abrahams, identified by Identity Number **9101175404083**, hereby acknowledge and affirm that I am the lawful owner of the dogs seized by the SPCA pursuant to the provisions of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 (together with Regulation 468) on 6 February 2025 from 168 Bunney street in Kensington, Cape Town. The said dog have since been admitted into the care of the SPCA under the respective Admission number:

In consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. Conditions for Return of Animals

- a. The Owner acknowledges that the animal identified below will be returned to the Owner's care subject to the following conditions:

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- i. The Owner shall maintain their property in a clean and hygienic manner by at all times.
 - ii. The Owner shall ensure that the dog is not subjected to hazardous material that could cause harm/ injury to the dog.
 - iii. The Owner shall ensure that the dog is provided with adequate veterinary care when needed.
 - iv. The owner is to ensure that the dog always has access to adequate water, food and shelter.
 - v. **NB. The owner shall not take the dog back to the property where it was confiscated from, 168 Bunney street in Kensington.**
- b. An Inspector of the SPCA shall be granted permission to inspect the animals at the Owner's premises at any reasonable time to ensure their welfare and compliance with the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962.
- c. That the owner shall not be afforded a second opportunity to ventilate this issue nor be entitled to any opportunity to negotiate the return of any animals should a second seizure become necessary and shall as a direct result thereof be charged criminally in the instance that an inspection conducted reveals any deviation from the above conditions.

2. Finality of SPCA's Decisions

The Owner acknowledges and agrees that any decision made by an officer of the SPCA regarding the welfare or disposition of the animals shall be final and binding.

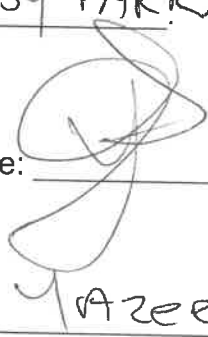
3. Costs Incurred

The Owner agrees to bear all costs incurred in connection with the enforcement of this agreement, including but not limited to legal fees and veterinary expenses.

4. Criminal Offences

The Owner understands that offences under the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 are criminal in nature. The SPCA reserves the right to prosecute or cause to be prosecuted any offence in relation to this contract, notwithstanding any other powers afforded to them by the Act. The Owner further understands that this matter may be referred to the criminal court should the Owner be suspected, on reasonable grounds, of having committed any offence in relation to the Act.
