I, Dr C. de Wet, was requested to perform a veterinary report on Monday, 12 March 2025 relating to a dog brought in by SPCA Inspector J. Mfini collected from 43 Honolulu Str, Tafelsig.

ANIMAL DETAILS

EXAMINATION FINDINGS

- **Description:**

She presented with a flea infestation. She had hair loss on her lower back, tail and back of hind legs. This distribution is most likely related to a flea bite allergy. Her incisors were all worn down. Her coat was rough. Her body condition score was 4.5/9 (mildly underweight). Skin scrape showed no abnormalities. She is not sterilized.

- **Duration** - Chronic
- **Prognosis** – Fair
- **Recommendation** – She should receive regular tick and flea treatment, such as Nexgard monthly or Bravecto every 3 months which will help restore the health of the skin and promote hair growth. She needs to be fed a better quality diet to improve her body condition score and improve her coat health. She needs to be sterilized in accordance with the Animal Keeping Policy of Cape Town.

COMMENTS

In my opinion this animal did not suffer too greatly and with the correct adjustments will be able to live a happy and comfortable life.
