Hello Tanyaradzwa,

We are sorry to hear about your situation. You can surrender the cat to the SPCA.

While we commit to our best possible efforts for every animal admission, surrendering an animal to the SPCA does not guarantee that your animal will be rehomed.

We are an open admissions facility, which means that we never turn any animal away. As a result, we often face capacity constraints, and as a charity, we have limited resources with which to care for a high volume of daily admissions.

The shelter environment can also be stressful for some pets who are accustomed to a home environment, and humane euthanasia may be considered for animals who are unable to cope.

We rehome animals responsibly, and for that reason, we cannot make animals with serious health issues or behavioural challenges (like aggression) available for adoption.

Please consider the above carefully and if you would like to continue with the surrender process, please bring your pet to our facilities in Grassy Park, on the corner of First Road and 1 st Ave.
