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As per the inspection conducted at Melkbossie Farm Animal Sanctuary (Melkbossie F.A.S) on Friday, 04 April 2025:

1. The shelter currently provided to your ponies and donkeys is only sufficient for summer periods. However, such shelter won't be sufficient in winter periods due to the wide openings at the top of the structure. Shelter used must afford adequate protection from rain, wind, and temperature extremes. We strongly suggest that you cover two (2) to three (3) sides of the structure's top openings with a suitable, non-hazardous material (which does not risk the animals ingesting it or becoming injured) so as to afford adequate windbreaks and maintenance of dry conditions in shelters.
2. The shelter currently provided to your pigs won't afford adequate protection from rain and adequate drainage of accumulated water. We strongly suggest that the shelters provided to your pigs are upgraded with solid flooring and a slope to prevent water accumulation inside the pigs' shelter and to afford adequate drainage, especially during periods of rain. Whilst it is ideal for a pig to have a mud wallow available to it in its enclosure, such cannot be in the shelter provided to the animal.

This warning has been issued in terms of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act No 169 of 1993.

Failure to comply with this warning may render you liable for prosecution under the Animals Protection Act No 71 of 1962 and / or Performing Animals Protection Act No 24 of 1935.

Any person who: - obstructs, hinders or resists an officer authorised in terms of the Animals Protection Act No 71 of 1962 or conceals any animal shall be guilty of an offence in terms of Section 8(4) of the aforementioned Act.
