History:

Layla presented to the AACL Epping on 27/02/2025 with the chief complaint of a suspected fracture as she was non weight bearing

Clinical Findings:

Clinically healthy, all vitals within normal limits, but non weight bearing on the Left Hind. Crepitus palpated on the tibia-fibula region.

Diagnostics:

We took x-rays. The x-rays showed a very bad tibia fracture.

Diagnoses:

Tibia Fracture-Suspected hit by car

Treatment:

Layla was started on inflacam and panado. The owner is cost sensitive and was given 3 options:

- 1) Attempt stabilization with bandages
- 2) Amputation
- 3) Humane Euthanasia

Additional Information:

We will attempt stabilization through bandages for 2 weeks. If desired stabilization not achieved with bandages then will have to amputate the leg.

Final decision will be made 31/3/2024 when Owner bring Layla in for bandage change and evaluation.
