My son Daniel and I were inside our home on the evening of Monday 24th March 2023 at approximately 19:00 / 19:30pm when we heard shouting and a smacking sound coming from my neighbour Kylie at no. 100 Glenoak Road, Welcome Glen. Kylie's daughter was in the road shouting "Help me". I proceeded to go outside to see what all the commotion was about. I ran up the side of my garage and in front of me in Kylie's front garden she had a fencing pole in her hand and was shouting, "stop it" and hitting her two dogs who were lying on their bellies next to each other motionless. I shouted at her three times, "What are you doing", she continued hitting the two dogs like she was in a trance. My neighbour directly across the road from no. 107 had come out of his gate, I shouted at him, "She's climbing into her dogs with a stick", he then went and got his hosepipe. At this point Kylie had stopped hitting the dogs, she dropped the stick and told me to go away man, and went back into her house.

I then instructed my son, Daniel to call the SPCA from my phone 0712802983 as I was left traumatised. We Daniel & I opened a case no. INSP 214557 which has since been closed. I feel that this case has not been investigated properly and that it should be reopened due to the fact that were the injuries suffered by the two dogs consistent to a dog fight?

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
