Good morning Jaco,

I have been in contact with the owner. He laid claim to the dog within the seven days.

We then discussed the matter internally and came to the conclusion that the dog may be returned to the owner, provided that he procures the necessary veterinary treatment. We got a quote from hospital of R2 500 for the biopsy and the growth removal and then the standard R500 for the pound fee (R3 000 in total). We also gave him the option to procure veterinary treatment at a private vet clinic but if this was the case, Beeno would have to be taken to the vet by us and only after the vet had cleared him, would he be allowed to go home.

I posed this to the owner in a meeting we had and he asked if he could go see if he could find a cheaper option. I have had no response from the owner since. I sent him a message which has not yet gone through and tried to call him but to no avail.

Could you please advise on a way forward with this matter?

I trust you are well and that in the event that Beeno is returned to his owner that the SPCA will continue to do regular checks to see that Beeno's basic needs are met:-

1. ADEQUATE APPROPRIATE QUALITY food and CLEAN water every day.
2. Medical check ups and reports from a registered vet until he is 100% healed.

3. Annual Vaccinations against parvo, kennel cough, rabies, etc.

4. As he has a short haired coat that he has a warm bed and blankets in his kennel for the freezing cape winters if he is not allowed to sleep indoors.
