Good day

Around a month ago, I submitted an in depth neglect report regarding Honeyvale Farm in Philadelphia. I would just like to inform that there are still horses in terrible condition, who from posts on social media and word of mouth from a source who works there that the horses are still deteriorating and not getting better.

Yet they have new horses coming in?

The inspector that called me with an update said the owners claimed it was ulcers, bare in mind, in horses in order to confirm ulcers a horse needs to be scoped by the vet, the horses owners also claimed the deterioration was due to an infestation of worms, if this was the case, after dewormer the condition of these animals should have improved.

This is extremely concerning as this yard is well known to be a constant black dot in the equestrian community, yet everyone feels despondent at the fact that it seems not enough is being done for these animals, not by the owners and not by the spca.

I have attached photos of 2 of the horses in the worst condition, these animals are still being asked to do strenuous work such as jumping ect. This shouldn't be acceptable.
