Thank you for your email.

I have reviewed the case and the photos attached to the case. Currently, there are no contraventions in terms of the Animals Protection Act, which means the SPCA cannot take action. Our last inspection was on 3 April 2025. The dogs were in acceptable condition with access to food, water and shelter. We have scheduled another follow-up for later this month.

Have you reported the breeding to Law Enforcement? The SPCA has no jurisdiction over the breeding of animals as this regulation falls within the ambit of the City of Cape Town Animal Keeping By Law, which is enforced by Law Enforcement. If you have not yet reported it to Law Enforcement, then don't hesitate to get in touch with them on 021 480 7700 – ask them for a reference number so that you can follow-up later.
