Comments: After speaking with Piete, the manager at the workshop, he escorted me to the current location of the owl. The owl appeared to be in good condition and showed no visible signs of injury.

Piete raised concerns about the owl not receiving food and mentioned that the bird becomes more active at night, frequently triggering the security alarm system. I informed Piete that, as owls are nocturnal, there may be a better chance of the bird leaving the premises during the evening if the shutter doors remain open. However, he stated that due to security concerns and the risk to valuable equipment, it is not possible to leave any shutters open overnight.

As the owl is perched high up in the roof trusses and is not injured, I advised Piete to contact CapeNature for assistance with the safe removal of the animal. He informed me that he is still awaiting a response from a lady named Michelle and a man named Brandon, whom he had previously dealt with regarding similar situations.
