All the animals appeared to be in a fair condition, except for the one pige that appeared to have a beak concern, the Pigeon was signed over as unwanted.

Then I requested the owner to put more artificial plants into the fish tanks, he immediately complied by adding more of them.

The living environment was clean, there was drinkable water for all animals.

As per note says, we need to get the details of the tortoises supplier, Mogamat told me that, the old man who supplied him with tortoises refused to give him his details.

I think we may close the case.
