General Report Comments: On my arrival at the property, I met with the Tanya Sheldon, who was with her colleague, they were coming from Environment Health Department, their telephone number was 021 400 4076. They were also there to conduct the inspection.

We have met with a man who Introduced himself as Zain Thomas, and Abdullah Bartlett, the allowed us onto the property. After I have told them the nature of the complaint.

I have observed the dog that appeared to be Injured on his back left leg, the dog was roaming freely inside the property. I wanted to know from Zain what happened to the dog, he mentioned that the dog was attacking the chickens then hit dog, I told them to surrender the dog, they agreed and it was signed as unwanted

I told him that is not acceptable, and they go to jail for a long time, if the animal is causing problems the owner is allowed to surrender the animal over to SPCA

Then we proceeded to the back of the house, where I have observed 12 chicken that were roaming freely inside, they appeared to be in a fair condition.

I also observed a pony and a horse, both animals appeared to be in a fair condition, the Pony was roaming freely at the back of the back of the house, while the horse was confined into the stables, the stable appeared to be adequate for the horse, however,

the roof was not high enough for the horse, the horse was able to touch the roof with the head, that can cause unnecessary suffering and uncomfortable ad the horse might the roof by the head .

There was clean water provided to the animals, and there food. The owner need to buy a flycatcher as I have noticed the high numbers of flies around the stables.

The warning was issued as follows.

1. To lift the roof of the shelter higher within 82 hours.
2. To provide the adequate treatment without any delays when the animal is injured amd to stop abusing the animals as we may take further steps should we get any evidence to support the allegations.
3. To buy the flycatcher within 72 hours
