What surprised me, it was when the owner wanted to know what was wrong with the dogs as if he doesn't see anything wrong with dogs.

There was no dog food, however there were many placed for dogs to sleep, they sleep inside the house and also outside there was a makeshift shelter, there was water provided to the dogs.

Nadeen is disabled, it appears as if he was shot by many bullets on his leg, I have advised him to surrender atleast the thin dog called Zara, him and his family refused.

Then I had no choice but to issue a warning as follows.

1. To provide the dogs wirh adequate food on a daily basis .
2. To take both dogs to the veterinarian for adequate treatment within 72 hours
