After I was informed that Sasha had been eating less and appears to be getting old. I made the handler take her out so I could record her gait and check her teeth. I found that Sasha's teeth were broken and dirty and she had a stiff gait in her hind legs. The warning was issued for Sasha to be taken to the vet and for Dogs and All to confirm when a dog is considered eligible for retirement.
