Dear SPCA Team,

I hope this message finds you well. I am reaching out again regarding the cats from my backdoor neighbors (18 Beacontree Ln, Woodstock). I believe their 1 sick cat was surrendered to your care in November after your last visit. As I previously mentioned, I believe the remaining two cats may also be facing health issues that require urgent attention.

I have been caring for these cats for several years to help maintain harmony in the neighborhood. Unfortunately, this has led to ongoing conflicts, as they frequently invade my space, disrupting my own cat's well-being and frequently attempt to steal his food if any doors or windows are left open and unattended. Despite my best efforts, I can only do so much for them financially and logistically.

The Tabby has a persistent skin condition, and I am particularly concerned about the Ginger cat. His dental health appears to be deteriorating, with visible gum disease and missing teeth, and one tooth looking heavily infected, making it difficult for him to eat. This situation is really affecting my cat's quality of life, as he is now fearful to go outside, and I can no longer enjoy my garden due to their presence and their waste.

They start to vocalize outside my door before sunrise and persist throughout the day, seeking help even in inclement weather, which is a clear indication of their distressing living conditions. I feel compelled to reach out for your assistance, again, as the situation has really become untenable.
