I never got the chance to conduct another follow up inspection.

Both the owner and manager of the shop have been warned twice to lessen the stocking densities of their fish tanks, to humanely euthanise any compromised fish, to provide their fish with adequate hiding space (which is definitely necessary due to their stocking densities), to remove any fish kept in jars and place them into suitable tanks, to provide birds with adequate and sufficient perching, to remove hazardous objects from bird enclosures, to provide the rabbit outside with an adequate hide/ shelter, and to clean any boxes with accumulated faeces and containing birds being hand-reared.

Please can this pet shop be allocated to the relevant Area Inspector to conduct a final follow up inspection and ensure the following has been complied to:

- Stocking densities of fish tanks have been reduced (no more overcrowding of fish).
 - If there appear to be compromised fish, Inspector must make them pts the fish in front of them so they can ensure they pts properly (I taught them how during my last inspection and so there is no excuse).
 - Fish have adequate hiding space if there are a lot of fish in one tank (even if not overcrowded).
 - No fish are being kept in small jars (pay special attention to beta fish / Siamese fighting fish), and all fish are in appropriate tanks.
 - Birds have been provided with adequate and sufficient perching opportunities .
