Thank you for your report submitted via our website.

Please be advised that our Inspectors have visited the property in question on five separate occasions since March 2025. During these inspections, it was confirmed that the dogs have access to adequate shelter. While we understand your concern regarding the dogs being in the rain, it is important to note that if animals have access to shelter but choose not to utilise it, the SPCA is unable to take further action unless there is a clear contravention of the Animals Protection Act.

With regard to the breeding of the dogs, this matter has been reported to Law Enforcement on multiple occasions. We are pleased to inform you that the SPCA has since sterilised both adult dogs.

Should you have concerns regarding persistent crying or barking, we recommend that you report this to Law Enforcement by calling 021 480 7700, as it may constitute a disturbance of the peace. This matter unfortunately falls outside the SPCA's mandate.

Thank you once again for your concern and for caring about animal welfare.
